### 1. Open Discussion

**Angela Pope (Community College of Beaver County)** introduced new key facilitator Amber Lutes, she formerly worked for CYS. The program helps with financial assistance for students with TANF or SNAP.

**Monique Anderson (Harmony House)** shared that the new recovery and wellness program is open. Clients must have an open CYS case and they must be working with a housing program. Recovery and wellness provides assistance to the community to connect resources and to help overcome barriers.

**Cami Williams (Mental Health Association)** reminded the group of the upcoming mental health training on September 17<sup>th</sup> from 1 pm to 4 pm at the Mental Health Association.

**Zabriawn Smith (Housing Opportunities)** shared that they can provide assistance for closing cost or grants to purchase a home. He reminded the group of upcoming workshops September 18<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm in Aliquippa and September 19<sup>th</sup> in New Castle.

**Nancy Grieco (Red Cross)** reported one single family fire in Beaver County, the family has insurance and is being taken care of. Nancy also shared on October 12<sup>th</sup> from 9 am to 3 pm the red cross will be installing smoke detectors.

**Dina (CoC)** announced that they are seeking to hire a data quality analyst to work with the HMIS program. The position will pay \$1500 monthly.

Aria shared that Crop and Kettle is a 16 week job training program that focuses on teaching cooking and restaurant readiness skills to help individuals achieve livable wages. They aim to instill value and purpose in students through programs like culinary training and agriculture taught by their skilled team. The program can accommodate up to 24 students per year offering hands on training with results of certificates, job placement, or even opening their own business. Crop and Kettle also assist local communities by donating vegetables to low income families, providing fresh produce and also through catering services.
